

# Aldelo<sup>®</sup> DRM Client – Quick Start Guide

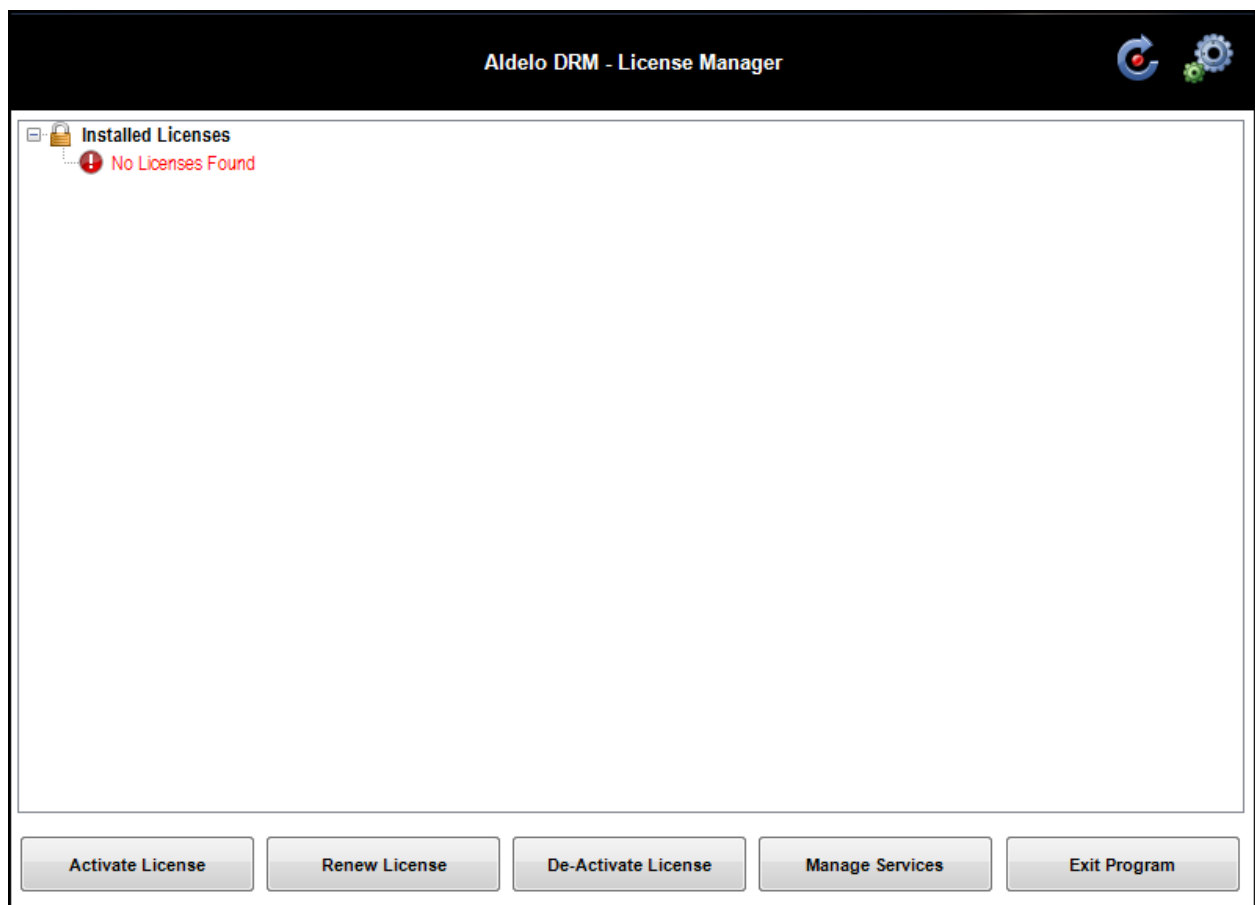
The Aldelo<sup>®</sup> DRM (Digital Rights Management) Client is used to activate, deactivate, and renew the licenses for your Aldelo software products. Follow the steps below to install the software.

Before installation, the first thing you must do is verify that Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 Extended is installed on your computer. If it isn't, download it from the Microsoft website or check with your network administrator.

Next, go to Windows Update and make sure your computer has all current updates from Microsoft. Perform an update and when you are finished, check again to see if any further updates are available. Continue in this manner until there are no further updates available for your computer.

Finally, verify in Windows that the date, time zone, and current time of day are accurate. In addition, set the clock to automatically adjust for Daylight Saving Time.

To access the Aldelo<sup>®</sup> DRM Client from your computer desktop, navigate to **Start Button > All Programs > Aldelo EPS > DRM End Point** and then click on the “Aldelo DRM Client” menu item to display the Aldelo<sup>®</sup> DRM – License Manager screen (See Figure 1).

## Installed Licenses

The list of licenses that are already installed appears in the main panel of the screen. Select a license from this screen by clicking on it. If nothing appears in the list, then you currently have no Aldelo software product licenses installed on the computer.

## “Manage Services” Button

From the Aldelo® DRM Client screen, click the “Manage Services” button to access the setup screen for the Aldelo® DRM – License Manager.

## “Install Service” Button

Click the “Install Service” button to begin the setup procedure (See Figure 2).

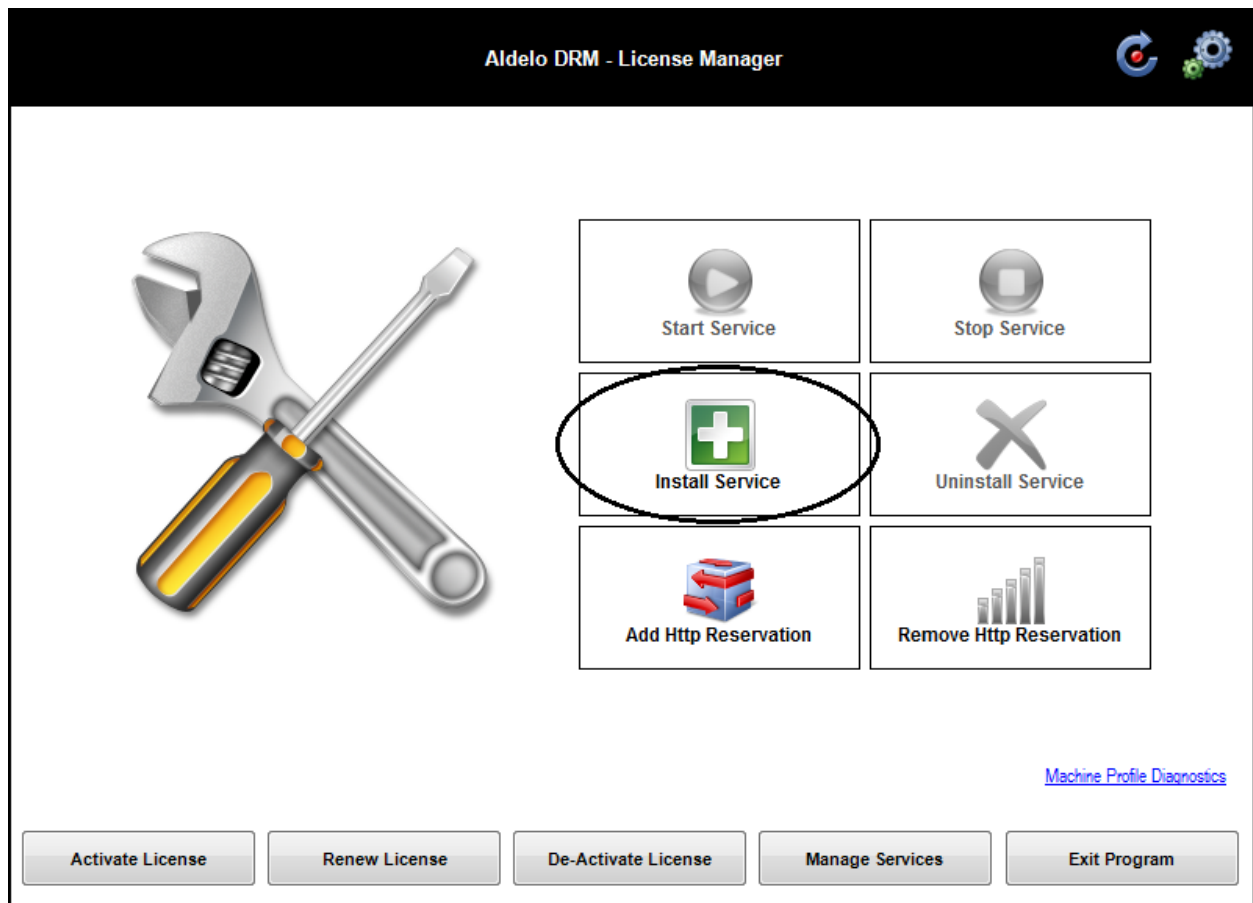
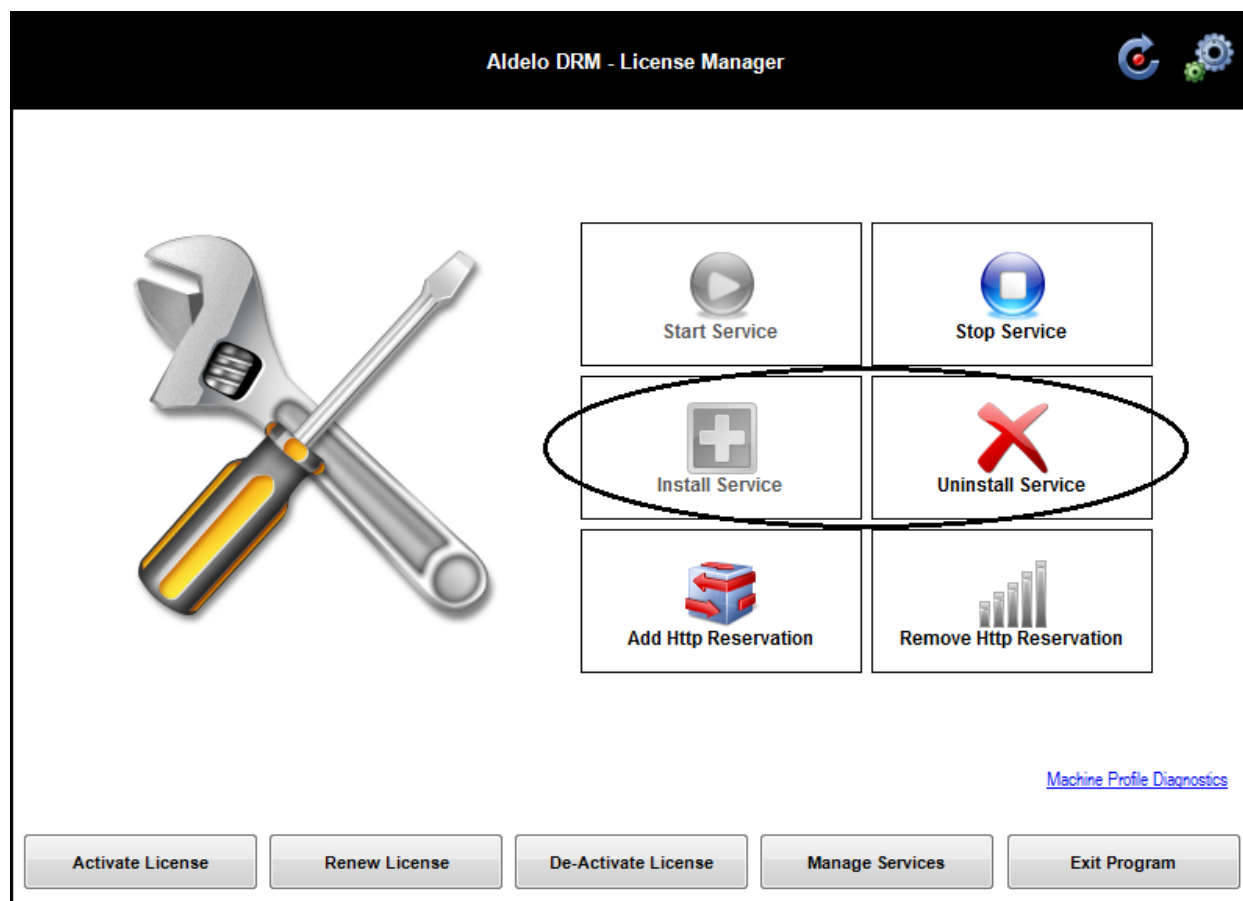

The installation proceeds automatically. When the “Install Service” button becomes disabled and the “Uninstall Service” button becomes enabled, your installation is complete. The service has now been installed and is running (See Figure 3).

#### **“Uninstall Service” Button**

Click the “Uninstall Service” button if you no longer have a need to run the License Manager software and wish to remove it from your system. On the Confirm Service Uninstall window that appears, click the “Yes” button.

#### **“Stop Service” Button**

Click the “Stop Service” button anytime the service is currently running and you wish to stop it. The service is running anytime the “Stop Service” button is currently enabled.

#### **“Start Service” Button**

Click the “Start Service” button anytime the service is not currently running and you wish to start it. The service is not running anytime the “Start Service” button is currently enabled.

**“Add Http Reservation” Button**

Click the “Add Http Reservation” button when you wish to add an Http namespace reservation. In the following windows, enter the information as prompted in each one and click the “OK” button. When the Addition Performed window displays, the namespace reservation addition request has been performed successfully. Click the “OK” button to exit the Add Http Reservation feature.

**“Remove Http Reservation” Button**

Click the “Remove Http Reservation” button when you wish to remove a previously added Http namespace reservation. In the following windows, enter the information as prompted in each one and click the “OK” button. When the Remove Performed window displays, the namespace reservation removal request has been performed successfully. Click the “OK” button to exit the Remove Http Reservation feature.
